

SAFARI SAMPLE ITINERARY

Duration: 5 Days

Route: Arusha/Moshi – Lake Manyara – Serengeti National Park – Ngorongoro Crater – Arusha/Moshi

Area: Northern Circuit

Itinerary:

Day 1: Arusha/Moshi – Lake Manyara

After breakfast 8:30 am, you will be picked up from your hotel and head towards Lake Manyara. This small park is home of wonderful species of birds, including pelicans, flamingos, storks and cormorants. Many mammals such as bushbucks, elephants, waterbucks, giraffes, wildebeests, zebras, baboons, monkeys, lions and leopards can be seen roaming the forest and the acacia-dotted plains of the park. After your picnic lunch proceed with afternoon game drive before you leave the park for dinner and overnight at a lodge or camp.

Day 2: Lake Manyara – Serengeti National Park

Early in the morning after breakfast you will drive to Serengeti National Park through Ngorongoro Conservation Area, with an optional visit to Olduvai Gorge, the archeological site of the Leakey family. Game en-route as you proceeds to your camp/lodge for dinner and overnight.

Day 3: Serengeti National Park

In the morning you get to enjoy a sunrise game viewing in Serengeti National Park. You have the full day with morning and afternoon game drives to explore the amazing plains at the most famous National Park in Tanzania. Over a million wildebeest and about 200,000 zebras flow to the southern plains through this park from the northern hills. In the evening you will go to the camp or lodge for dinner and overnight.

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Day 4: Serengeti National Park – Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast you will continue your wildlife safari in the Serengeti National Park. In the Seronera valley you can watch the wildebeests, zebras as well as lions and other big cats such as leopards and cheetahs. After lunch at a picnic place, you will slowly drive in the direction of the Ngorongoro Crater. As soon as the crater's edge is reached you will have a superb view into the caldera. You will enjoy dinner and overnight at the camp or lodge along the Crater's rim.

Day 5: Ngorongoro Crater – Arush/Moshi

You will eat breakfast before driving into the Crater. The Ngorongoro Crater is the largest unbroken and unfolded caldera in the world and will fascinate you with unbelievable wildlife diversity! On the grass steppe and in the acacia tree woods you will find almost all species found on the East African savanna. After an extensive wildlife tour and a picnic lunch at the hippo pool, you will leave the crater in the afternoon and drive back to Arusha/Moshi.
